



New Breath Foundation (NBF) is a national community-led (501c)3 foundation supporting Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) communities harmed by incarceration, detention, and deportation.

In 2021, we launched the *We Got Us* Fund to combat anti-Asian violence through cross-racial solidarity and community-based alternatives to criminalization—cultivating healing and protecting our communities together.

The Impact: 5 Years of Transformation

We don't just provide grants; we catalyze organizational growth. Since the inception of *We Got Us*, we have achieved:

- **\$7.7M+** in direct grantmaking (unrestricted six-figure grants).
- **\$2M+** in additional capacity-building support.
- **30 Grantee Partners** across **20 states**, serving **54,000 individuals**.
- **61%** of partners grew their operating budgets by an average of **\$550K** after partnering with NBF.
- **71%** of partners hired much-needed staff to expand capacity.

We amplify the voices that matter most—directly impacted AANHPI organizations fighting to end the violence of incarceration, detention, and deportation. Collective liberation depends on solidarity, not division. **By centering formerly incarcerated leaders in our funding, we believe lived experience drives lasting community transformation and systems change.**
